The 1989 Chevrolet Corvette introduced minor changes, the biggest being the introduction of the six-speed manual transmission manufactured by ZF (Zahnradfabrik Friedrichshafen). French inventors Louis-Rene Panhard and Emile Levassor are credited with the development of the first modern manual transmission.
