I have a 1997 model John Deere 8875 skid loader. Deere was buying them from New Holland at that time. I'm pretty sure it's the same model as your LX885. I have never done it yet but the cab will tilt. My service manual does not give any details on tilting the cab forward other than to consult the dealer.
