Manual mode. In ~[?], choose an ISO, aperture, and shutter speed based on the exposure meter 's guidance. You will now be able to take individual pictures of each person, no matte r where they are standing within the circle, without needing to adjust anything, and each shot will have a consistent exposure. Manual Exposure is when the photographer manually sets the aperture, ISO and shutter speed all independently of each other in order to adjust exposure. This gives them full creative control over the output of the image .In the previous lesson we covered the basic settings on your camera. Today we're jumping into the fun stuff: manual mode. Manual mode requires the photographer to make all the decisions that determine an image's exposure, as opposed to an automatic or semi-automatic mode that makes at least some of the calls for the photography. Manual exposure gives the maximum amount of control to the photographer.
