Peritoneal dialysis (per-ih-toe-NEE-ul die-AL-uh-sis) is a way to remove waste products from your blood when your kidneys can no longer do the job adequately. A cleansing fluid flows through a tube (catheter) into part of your abdomen and filters waste products from your blood. After a prescribed ...**OVERVIEW.** Peritoneal dialysis (PD) is a procedure that can be used by people whose kidneys are no longer working effectively. It does not cure or treat the underlying kidney disease.**INDICATIONS.** Extraneal (icodextrin peritoneal dialysis solution) is indicated for a single daily exchange for the long (8- to 16- hour) dwell during continuous ambulatory peritoneal dialysis (CAPD) or automated peritoneal dialysis (APD) for the management of end-stage renal disease.Extraneal (icodextrin peritoneal dialysis solution) is also indicated to improve (compared to 4.25% dextrose ...Updated January 26, 2005 **What everyone should know about Peritoneal Dialysis** Bryan J.
