OSHA's Confined Space Standard OSHA's standard for confined spaces (29 CFR 1910.146) contains the requirements for practices and procedures to protect employees in general industry from the hazards of entering permit spaces. Permit-Required Confined Spaces QUICK. CARD. TM. A confined space has limited openings for entry or exit, is large enough for entering and working, and is not designed5 "Hazardous atmosphere" means an atmosphere that may expose employees to the risk of death, incapacitation, impairment of ability to self-rescue (that is, escape unaided from a permit space), injury, or acute illness fromA non-permit required confined space is a space that does not contain or, with respect to atmospheric hazards, have the potential to contain any hazard capable of causing death or serious physical harm.
