For a nonfiction piece, choose interesting or compelling facts or ideas about which students will read. Include some just as they are presented in the text; for others, reverse the truth of the statement to make it more controversial or more appealing to common sense. Quick Write/Quick Draw Quick Write/Quick Draw is a literacy strategy that gives students the opportunity to reflect on their learning. Instructions: An anticipation guide is a comprehension strategy that is used before reading to activate students' prior knowledge and build curiosity about a new topic.
