

# Download Relative Short Story By Chris Van Wyk

The common hippopotamus (*Hippopotamus amphibius*), or hippo, is a large, mostly herbivorous, semiaquatic mammal native to sub-Saharan Africa. It is one of only two extant species in the family Hippopotamidae, the other being the pygmy hippopotamus (*Choeropsis liberiensis* or *Hexaprotodon liberiensis*). The name comes from the ancient Greek for "river horse" (????????). *Memoirs Online* is the online photo collection of Collinsville, a small community in Central Queensland. Nearly 10 years in the making, the complete archive includes over 20,000 images scanned and sent in by both present and past residents of Collinsville. *Sides'* history highlights lessons from one of America's few large-scale conventional conflicts in the post-World War II era. *Sides'* story highlights the risk of miscalculating a foreign power's intention to intervene in a conflict, the American predilection to over-rely on technology in warfare, and the enduring importance of experienced leadership in combat.
