

# Download Somchem Hand Loading Manual

Handloading or reloading is the process of loading firearm cartridges or shotgun shells by assembling the individual components (case/hull, primer, powder, and bullet/shot), rather than purchasing completely assembled, factory-loaded ammunition. The term handloading is the more general term, as it refers to assembly of ammunition using components from any source. But of course in the same vein there are so many propellants with a wide application. RL 17 (and possibly 15) maybe has an even wider practical usage spread than 3031 and it has proper burn rate chemicals and not physical graphite coating to inhibit flame spread so you do not blacken your fingers due to all that unburnt carbon when removing or picking up your empty cases. snake eyes I hunt and shoot with a .458 WM more than any other caliber. My rifle is a Colt Sauer Grand African for Bear and Deer. The bullet I shoot is the RanchDog 350 gr FNGC cast in certified #2 alloy.
