Penguin Galaxy and Penguin Orange. Penguin Books is a British publishing house. It was co-founded in 1935 by Sir Allen Lane, his brothers Richard and John, as a line of the publishers The Bodley Head, only becoming a separate company the following year. Penguin revolutionised publishing in the 1930s through its inexpensive paperbacks, sold through Woolworths and other high street stores for sixpence, bringing high-quality ... In 1996, Penguin Books published as a paperback *A Complete Annotated Listing of Penguin Classics and Twentieth-Century Classics* (ISBN 0-14-771090-1).. This article covers editions in the series: black label (1970s), colour-coded spines (1980s), and the most recent editions (2000s).
