The Dreyfus Affair (French: l'affaire Dreyfus, pronounced [la.fʁɑ̃ dʁɛ.fys]) was a political scandal that divided the Third French Republic from 1894 until its resolution in 1906. The affair is often seen as a modern and universal symbol of injustice, and it remains one of the most notable examples of a complex miscarriage of justice and antisemitism. The term has also more generally been applied to the historical era following modernity and the tendencies of this era.
